

CELEBRATING A FANTASTIC YEAR OF 2022 AND A HAPPY NEW YEAR TO EVERYONE



2022 proved to be one of the most successful years in the history of Phoenix Taekwondo! The highlight of the year was our Elements Stage Show, performed at the Amey Theatre, Abingdon, raising £2500 for the local 'Be Free Young Carers' charity. In addition, we managed 3 club gradings in the Spring, Summer and Winter terms, plus two Little Dragons Belt Gradings. It has been great to see the change in belt colours across all classes as everyone progresses and improves their Taekwondo.

In addition to the Elements Show, the club performed two public demonstrations, being invited by the Mayor's office to put on a performance at the Queen's Platinum Jubilee celebrations in the Summer. We also volunteered for a week teaching Taekwondo in local primary schools.

We have a newly qualified competition referee (Jon) as well as an award for the best competition referee (Eunmi). We participated in the National Poomsae Championships, the Welsh international and the Bluewave championships (where the club was awarded the Bronze team trophy) amassing 54 medals including 3 national champions.

Finally the club managed to add 14 new or higher qualified Black Belts, passing the National Examinations.
